[†] The fixture against Athletico Neasden resulted in a prolonged dispute between Temple Fortune and the Management Committee of the Maccabi (Southern) Football League. Temple Fortune established that Athletico Neasden (3rds) had fielded more than the two players permitted to drop from a higher team, which was a breach of the League Rules. The Club requested an inquiry and were sent copies of the relevant team sheets verifying that Athletico had in fact played four ineligible players. However, instead of awarding the points to Temple Fortune for Neasden's clear cut offence, the Management Committee mysteriously allowed the result to stand, causing a strong objection to be lodged. No explanation for the League's astounding decision was forthcoming!
