Unplayed matches

v Bushey United, League (home):
Points lost by default; Temple Fortune were unable to raise a team.

The League fixture against Scrabble on March 18th was abandoned with the score level at 1-1. Temple Fortune had three players sent off for general swearing (but **not** at the referee). The third player to be dismissed was Neil Harris – a registered non-member – who adopted a threatening attitude towards the referee, Ronnie Marlowe. Harris was restrained by other Temple Fortune players but Marlowe panicked and hastily left the venue, having abandoned the match. Because the match had been played in a good sporting spirit, the two teams agreed to complete the fixture as a friendly with Scrabble manager Adrian Lewis taking over as referee. Harris was immediately expelled from the Club who called Lewis to give evidence supporting Temple Fortune's case. However, at the subsequent London Football Association disciplinary hearing, the Club were fined £90 including costs and warned as to its future conduct. Harris collected a massive three-figure fine and suspension of five months, the severest penalty ever imposed on a Temple Fortune player. The M(S)FL awarded the points to Scrabble and the Club decided to omit the result of the friendly (a 2-2 draw) from these records. As a direct consequence of this incident involving a non-member, the Club's rules were amended so that **all** players have to join as members and sign an agreement which includes an understanding to 'refrain from participating in misconduct'.
